



MAINTENANCE TECHNICIAN

Duties will include, but are not limited to:

- Provide lubrication of blowers, pumps, and moving parts in accordance with manufacturer.
- Replace belts, change air filters preventatively or as needed.
- Replace electric motors, submersible pumps, or other machinery as needed.
- Replace electrical components such as relays, starters, switches, timers, floats, etc.
- Visually inspect and test machinery and equipment for excessive wear or defects and proper operation.
- Clean and lubricate shafts, bearings, gears, and other parts of machinery.
- Must adhere to company and safety standards for maintaining equipment.
- Must obtain and stay current on assigned safety training.
- Must be able to read electrical control diagrams.
- Confined space entry.
- Lay out, assemble, install, and maintain pipe systems and related equipment, and repair and replace gauges, valves, pressure regulators, and related equipment.
- Electrical controls troubleshooting.
- Operation of hand tools, power tools, and safety equipment.
- Minor repair and fabrication.
- Operation of a company vehicle and maintain a good driving record.
- Recordkeeping and organization.
- Other duties and/or projects may be assigned.

Must be able to work independently, attentive to detail, closely follow written and oral instructions, and have the ability to lift 50 pounds.
